





Flow of donations all throughout the journey of 17 years has infused energy to team Sanjivani to take up different tasks for upliftment of society.

Over the years since inception, sanjivani has coined various activities from Health Care-to Education-to Women Empowerment-to skill development-to Relief Activity during pandemic of COVID-19, and Free Dialysis Services.

Depending on availability of Qualified Doctors post covid pandemic we went on adding one Medical Mobile van after another and at present 4 Mobile Medical Van are operating in two villages daily in 28 days cycle every month In nearly 192 villages across three districts of Gujarat namely Kheda, Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar in prescheduled manner. Every Sunday 2 medical Vans cover 8 Villages every month in prescheduled manner total in 200 villages / month

Every Sunday mobile Dental and Ophthalmic van is operating in different villages from above mentioned 200 villages.

Tele medicine Van with ECG facility is operating in each route every three to four months providing ECG facility also.



We started dialysis centre in our premises with five machines. We are highly thankful to Jewelex foundation, Mumbai to supported financially for this project. From 12th July, 2021 on auspicious day of Rathayatra, this was inaugurated with all necessary permissions from respective authorities. We have applied for empanelment with GOG ,under PMJAY yojana, which is near to be sanctioned. Till this date (August 22) we have provided this dialysis facility free of charge to nearly 23 patients enrolled and 1950 dialysis procedures have been performed safely.

In our dialysis Centre we received donation for installing 65 KV diesel generator set from Smt. Jyotsanaban V. Shah in Memory of Lt. Shri. Vinodchandra Ramanlal Shah, as well as donations for **4 Fresenius** dialysis machines one each from

Certain alarming facts about Dialysis Patient

Over last 14 months of our nearly 2000 Dialysis procedures We have observed that day by day the patients with younger age becoming victim to chronic kidney disease are increasing exponentially. Younger age end stage renal diseases are also increasing very fast. Patients with end stage renal failure / chronic kidney disease stage 5 only have two options, either to live with hemodialysis till they live or to go for the kidney transplantation. There are still many barriers for kidney transplant in our country. There are numerous patients who do not have MAA or PMJAY Card. creating huge financial burden on patient families. Patients with card or

without card are attended at our centre. We provide free dialysis without any hidden cost .The youngest patient is of 27 years age other six other patients are below age of 38, which is quite alarming. Happy to share with you that the first patient of a Centre Ganesh bhai had only 15-20% functioning of the heart. He was denied any cardiac intervention or surgery at both government and private institutions. He had to live on dialysis only and today he has completed 206 dialysis at our centre. We at Sanjivani are sincerely thankful to all donors and especially Dr Jay Shah our Nephrologist and his dedicated team for their services to ailing humanity.






