



It is indeed a matter of pride and privilege to present before you 15th annual report and share our feelings and ideas with you. Shubh Dipavali Greetings from Sanjivani Pariwar in advance.

A small initiative of providing primary medical care to rural population in 2005 has now established identity of Sanjivani as a symbol of credibility, transparency, commitment, a symbol of dedication, devotion & passion aided with selfless services of Doctors, volunteers and support Staff across all projects. Flow of donations all throughout the journey of 15 years has infused energy to team Sanjivani to take up different tasks for upliftment of society.

Over the years Sanjivani coined spectrum of service right from –

Health Care-to Education-to Women Empowerment-to skill development-to Relief Activity during pandemic of COVID-19

- Rural Health Program:
Upto March 2020, all mobile medical vans were working regularly to cover 208 villages including Sunday camps. PFA work report for the same.
- Mobile Dental Van- Mobile Ophthalmic van- Both team operates only on Sunday
- Mobile Telemedicine van

During the Covid-19 Pandemic all Rural Health activities were paralysed, with Senior Family Physicians Going to villages withdrawn due to age factor, Family restraints, daily tiresome travelling and possible risk of getting COVID-19 infection looking to their age and also during initial lock down period all movements were restricted. We sincerely convey our thanks to all these senior Family Physicians who gave their selfless services all these years, to establish credibility of our Rural Health Program. We are thankful to them for their services over years.

It was only after 5th July 2020 we restarted Rural Camps by starting 1st van and by August added 2nd van after obtaining prior permission from CDHO –Kheda and Ahmedabad, and undertaking from Rural stack holders about maintaining strict social distancing and asking beneficiaries to use Mask.

It is a novel project of providing basic Bio-Chemistry reports like Kidney function tests, Liver function tests, Lipid profile, Uric Acid, Haemoglobin estimation etc. at token rate as per the table below:

A fully equipped O.P.D. based diagnostic centre in name of Shantaben Shatilal Kothari (Jewelex India Mumbai)-Sanjivani Health Care Centre at present on an average 150 to 200 patients are getting facility of investigations, medical advice and benefit of generic medical store.

Our **Generic medical store** is providing medicines at most economical rate which poorest of poor can effort.

Sadhu saints of all religion are provided free services at the centre Poor patients are given sizable discount in our charges as the need may be. We are happy that all throughout four years since 2015 the revenue losses we have made have been donated by Jewelex India, Mumbai. This centre is managed by **Dr. Asit I. Dave.**

This year we have added more faculties like-

- Dental Implant treatment and OPG X-ray facility first time in the area by any NGO, Physio-Dispenser, Apex locator to improvise and strengthen Dental services.
- Online X-ray reporting facility throughout the day

- Intermittent Fasting Program for cases of Diabetes, Obesity, PCOD, cancer etc.
- Fundus Camera and surface tonometer for Eye department to strengthen Glaucoma and Diabetic Retinopathy work-up

In last week of March 2020, amidst COVID-19 Pandemic, we re-started the centre with a single OPD of Family Physician, Pharmacy, Laboratory, Radiology and Physiotherapy in single session.

From August we added other few departments as per availability of Faculties.

Our effort is to provide latest technological treatment at most affordable rate to poorest of the poor.

Needy patients requiring further hospitalization or investigations for major illnesses are referred to network hospitals and are given sizable financial support for investigation like coronary angiography, Dialysis etc.

We are proud to say that all consultant Doctors at "Sanjivani health Care Centre", other Doctors and paid staff and volunteers have worked on all week days excluding Sunday and just 5 holidays in the year tirelessly to enrich our satisfaction of being instrumental in extending helping hand to

underprivileged community.

Even during crisis of COVID-19 period cash discounts were given to needy patients in all services including Generic medical store, so that no one in need goes back without treatment.

Women empowerment

“Sanjivani Suraksha” Sanitary Napkin Project:

Shri S M Nanavati Charitable Trust donated for this project in 2015. Since January 2016 till date, we have been successful in manufacturing 16,00,000 pads by cottage industry model, a unique one in Gujarat by any NGO. So far we have distributed 14,50,000 pads to underprivileged rural beneficiaries, at most affordable rates or even free to school and college girls ,ladies in childbearing age in villages so as to improve their hygiene level during menstrual cycles.Smt. Ushaben Parmar and her 2 team has worked tirelessly to spread awareness about menstrual hygiene to women of more than 240 villages and more than 500 + women are working at ground level for distribution of Sani.Napkins.

In post COVID-19 pandemic phase: Even before medical vans, we had started van for this project in June 2020 to evaluate ground reality of villages so far pandemic is concerned. Please see the Data for the same below.

To fulfil the demand of end users to provide pads with wings, we entered into contract with one manufacturer and started distributing Wonderize Pads from December 2019 onwards.

Adolescent Health Counselling :

Since March-19 our team continued addressing adolescent youth between age of 10 to 18 years studying in primary and secondary schools. Our team has so far addressed 165 schools targeting both urban and rural students and have educated more than 30000 students followed by free sanitary pads distribution to more than 16000 girls for one year. In the year 2020-21 due to Covid-19 pandemic we had to suspend this activity. Smt. Smitaben Thaker our project Coordinator and Smt. Bhavnaben Shah had worked tirelessly for this project.

In the last year 2019-20 we had 996 students and Third batch appeared board exams of std. 10 in March 2020. We are happy to inform you that the third batch of Std. 10 comprising of 36 students also scored 84% result with continuous effort of students and teachers. The result itself shows the efforts put in by our dedicated teachers and continuous monitoring by trustees.

Over and above scholastic activity attention was focused on culture values, festival celebrations, Yoga, nutrition, medical health (Eye Check-up, dental check-up) and growth assessment. Sessions for Teachers Training and motivational sessions.

Due to Covid-19 Pandemic-School has not re-opened after lockdown and July 2020 onwards, online and offline education of principal subjects has been started through worksheets and you-tube videos captured at our school by different teachers. For assignment, parents were asked to collect exercise books from school and return to school after completion of the same. Three monthly exams have also been taken and evaluation of papers also done. This year due to migration of families following COVID-19, the number of students including new admissions in KG, has been around 954. Looking to the situation demand, our trust decided to waive off pending fees of last year and decreased current year fees by 50%. No computer fees are being collected this year(20-21)


