Our vision is to provide free education to girls, we are in process of discussion with our donors and shortly we are to announce the same.

In our education activity at Shiv Shala Complex due to shortage of parking and open space for playground we are not getting permission to increase the classes in both English and Gujarati Medium as per present guidelines of Education Department. We have been searching a land of 1000-1500 Sq. meters for the same. we have applied to Chief Minister Shree Bhupendrabhai Patel, Gandhinagr to help by alloting a plot for th same. We have also identified such land just 50 mts. away from the school building and we are trying to get guidance from legal advisor. This project is likely to cost us Rs.3,00,00,000/- for the land and once process of NA is done, we will construct need based building over there to shift our pre-primary KG 1-2 and Balvatika students of both medium and also Sanjivani Vidya Vihar classes gradually, so that we can start std 11-12 Commerce stream classes in present building, or can add short courses of skill development like wireman, Plumber, Mobile and Computer Repairing etc. after std. 10th. Also planning to promote masoom - Sanjivani - ELC classes by increasing no. of students.

I earnestly request all donors to extend hands of co-operation in the project, to fulfil our dream of Education for all without financial burdon on parents.

A small initiative of providing primary healthcare to flood devastated villages of Kheda district in year 2005 has now established itself as a symbol of transparancy, credibility and commitment with passion in the field of not only healthcare but also in education as well as Empowerment of woman.

During the period under review, our teams have performed exceptionally well in the in all areas.:

Rural healthcare project

With improved government health infrastructure and availability of medical services with wide range of available medicines at PHC level and certain village level, we have restricted our coverage of villages and are now we are focusing on those villages where no PHC or sub centre is available or villages having population around 2000 to 4000, we are covering 154 villages round the year at interval of 28 days and provide basic healthcare services keeping in mind NCD.

The Model of our rural project which provides medical service at village level is unique one which regularly provides medical services with primary focus on NCD (Noncommunicable diseases) like hypertension, diabetes,

Without shifting patient from village, through this Mobile ECG van we have been providing ECG with authenticated report by a physician in just 10 mins, and basic Laboratory facility like Haemoglobin. S. Creatinine and S. Cholesterol in less than 20 mins making treatment of NCD patients easy and in time.

heart disease and kidney disease in particular which we have found to be of immense value in providing early detection and best available treatment by qualified doctors at doorstep of underserved and marginalised rural population. We have observed that by giving these services regularly at the doorstep, the incidence of heart diseases, heart failure, brain stroke, and kidney failure -CKD has considerably reduced due to early intervention, detection and treatment. Daily six villages are being covered by our medical team at every 28 days cycle as per fixed schedule program.

On every Sunday, our Dental and ophthalmic van providing basic eye check-up, dental check-up as well as primary dental treatment and spectacle distribution service covering 50 villages each by both vans every year.

Our telemedicine Ambulance van donated by Waghbakri Foundation, couple of years ago, is equipped with online ECG facility and mobile Pathology laboratory which operates on pre-planned

routes covering all 154 villages every three months.

On Sunday one regular medical van is also providing service which covers five villages and arranging 45-50

camps per year.





Healthcare Centre started in year 2015 with generous support of Jewelex Family Mumbai. This centre is progressing in steady manner and achieving new milestones as year passes by. With trained and qualified staff and team of consulting doctors of different discipline, daily average patient is continuously increasing to 230 to 240 patients, we are equipped with all latest machines in our Dental, Pathology, Radiology and imaging department, which gives satisfactory results within stipulated time frame for quick diagnosis of ailment for all at most economical rates, table for faculty wise services at Sanjivani Health Care Centre is shown below.

Sanjivani urban clinic sponsored by Smt. Madhuben Jayantibhai Patel- Nagar Parivar started in 2011 operates daily between 2:30 PM to 5 PM offering medical care to needy population of surrounding at just token charges matching with rural project.

On 10-07-2024 Sanjivani is completing 19 years of service and the Board has decided to give 10 % special discount for one year to all senior citizen above 60 years. This will not apply to case charge, pharmacy bill and cosmetic treatment like dental implant and bracing. Of course discount on all services up to 20 % is being provided by authorize person under poor patient fund discount Scheme.





In July 2021 we had five dialysis machines, with the generous support of donors and hard work and dedication of our well-trained qualified staff, we have implemented expansion and our Number of Beds have increased to 10 and within short time, we are going to increase our strength to 12 beds with 12 latest Fresenius dialysis machine and targeting to provide 500 procedures every month to needy patients free of charge /under PMJAY scheme. We have already received donation and received two more dialysis machine of Fresenius Company. One from our esteemed donoe shri Chandrakantbhai B. Patel of MAMATA Machinaries Pvt Ltd and other from Vaishnav Samaj of



Chicago USA through shri Devendrabhai Parikh. We are in process of approval from various authorities like GPCB, PMJAY, and Fire NOC, after which we are shortly to start using making installed capacity of 600 Dialysis procedures a month. For this we are also increasing capacity of double R.O. Plant to match the uninterrupted increased need of 3-5 TDS R.O. water. Shri Ketanbhai Rasiklal Shah - HUF had donated for the expenditure for the same. We are sincerely thankful to all of them.

At present. We are having six eye surgeons out of which three eye surgeons are regularly doing phaco surgery, with the help of our well qualified OT staff.







To improve standard of learning and school achieving good academic record, admission was restricted to eligible students in terms of regularity in presence, behaviour, learning capacity and needy student only in new academic year. The school strength of students has been 984 for year 2024-25, to provide quality education with best technology, we have added four more smart boards to already installed six making total number of 10 smart boards. Through which best technology enriched education is being provided.



Various sessions for teachers training were arranged for smart board use, training and evaluation of teachers skills were done in presence of all teachers as a process of appraisal.

Average presence at our school has been between 85-90% throughout the year. Regular parents meeting were conducted to keep them updated regarding progress of their child, and to motivate them to keep a watch on academic progress of student.

Various events like launch of Chandrayaan-3 on the moon was shown to all students live in 10 classes. Various national programs are also being shown to students in these classes to keep them updated with the world. This year we have added to more rooms, one for Science laboratory, and another for Library, Spacious rooms equipped with all science equipment required between standard 5 to 10 and nearly 1000 books of various topics and subjects are being stored in our library. This was inaugurated on 26 January 2024 at the National Republic Day in presence of our trustee, Shri Upendra shah and Purnimaben Shah as well as, retired professor with double PHD in Economics from two universities and has trained more than 25 PhD students as a mentor- Shri Natubhai J. Patel. He addressed the students regarding importance of education in present world and in development of Healthy-prosperous nation.

In December 2023 when winter was at peak woollen Sweaters were distributed to all students of our school and Sanjivani-Masoom ELC students was arranged with generous donation from Kokilaben Charitable Trust of PRUDENT Corporation and support of Shri Vrajmohanbhai Shah of Reliable Art Printery (Ahmedabad) Pvt. Ltd.
